- When in use, sliding or transporting, please ensure that there are no people or pets nearby (the back, bottom, front and sides of the product), and that no foreign objects or pets inside the product, to avoid accidents.

  • Please use well-grounding power supply suited to this product.
- Please pull out the plug after use or before cleaning to avoid injury or damage to the product.
- Do not use unauthorized accessories.
- · Don't use this product outdoors.
- Please read this manual instruction carefully before operation.
- Any other usage that is not listed in this manual instruction is forbidden.
- Recommended usage time of this product is 20 minutes/ session.
- Please check if any part of this products is damaged before use. If so, please do not use it and contact us for repair.
- Please do not use it if the cover is broken or damaged.
- Please do not use it if the shell or surface is damaged.
- · Please do not drop anything into this product.
- · Please do not fall asleep while using this product.
- Please do not use it if drunk or feeling unwell.
- Please do not use it within one hour after having meal.
- Please do not adjust to the maximum intensity at the beginning of the massage to avoid the risk of being injured.
- Please do not keep sharp objects in pockets when use.
- Keep the plug clean from needles, rubbish or water.
- · If the power cord is damaged, do not attempt to change on your own. Please contact us for repair for safety reasons.



### 2. Environment for usage

- Please do not use it in a moist environment such as bathrooms.
- Please do not use it when there is a drastic change in temperature.
- Please do not use it under heavy-dusty or caustic environment.
- Please do not use it where there is not enough space or not good ventilation.
- Please switch off the power and unplug the machine after use.
- Please do not use it when surrounding temperature is up to 40°C.
- Please do not use it when surrounding temperature is below 5°C. The lubricant can thicken quickly and increase the friction between parts.
- Turn off and pull out the plug during thunderstorms.
- Place the product on a flat surface.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not place it near fire or directly under the sun.
- When moved from a low-temperature storage to a warm environment, the moisture inside the machine may affect, or damage, its functionality. Please rest the product within room temperature for 1 hour before use.

- Be away from this product during power cut to prevent injury in case power resumes suddenly.

### 6. Solution of ordinary malfunctions

- It is normal if the motor makes noises during operation.

- · If the rated working time is over, the power will automatically go off. If this product works continuously for too long, the temperature control will automatically turn off the machine, if so, please allow a 30-minute break before resuming.




When the calf rest is ascending during use, do not apply pressure on it. This is to prevent the massage chair from falling forward and causing damage or injury.




In "standby" mode, or when the massage chair has been connected to power, do not drag/ pull the power cord. Damage to the power plug (or its parts) due to forceful pulling/ dragging will cause damage to the product or possible electric shock. It is advised to unplug the massage chair and tie up the power cord when not in use.

The touch screen monitor holder is fixed. Do not pull the holder with too much force when using or moving the massage chair, to avoid damaging the chair.



# Name and Function of Components

## ) Function:

- · This product is equipped with a set of silent smart 3D massage heads which move up and down and; front and back.
- · Capable of automatically detecting and fine-tuning shoulder position; detecting body curve and shiatsu points to adjust accordingly the movement of the massage heads. This makes the massage experience more personal and scientific.
- Automatic 4 massage settings: Smart AI, Healthcare, Special and Relaxation, encompassing a total of 23 automatic massage programs.
- 3 memory programs: Memory I, Memory II, Memory III.
- Manual Massage Function for the upper body
  - \* 5 areas: full back, partial, fixed, upper back and lower back.
  - \* 7 massage modes: grasping, rolling, kneading, tapping, shiatsu, kneading and tapping and 3D massage.
  - \* Each mode has 5 intensity levels.
  - \* For tapping and shiatsu, the width between the massage heads can be adjusted among 5 levels.
- Arm air pressure massage: 8 built-in airbags along forearm area; and 4 along upper arm area. 3 intensity levels available.
- · Lower body air pressure massage: 4 built-in airbags along waist area; 4 along leg area; and 16 along foot area. 3 intensity levels available.
- Back heating function: Using carbon fiber as the source of infrared heating.
- "Zero-space": the forward-sliding design eliminates the large space requirement between the chair and the wall.
- · Music player system: 3D digital speakers installed above each armrest. Connect to your smart device and play music via Bluetooth.
- Twisting massage function: using the left-and-right movement of the airbags at waist area to perform and waist-twisting function. Effectively relaxes stiff waist muscle from longtime
- Quick control panel, with negative ion button, sit-up and recline buttons, zero-gravity button, power button, auto mode button and leg extension button etc., is located on the right armrest.
- · Leg rest height adjustment, synchronized seat and leg height adjustment, zero gravity I and zero gravity II.
- Calf kneading function: kneading in opposite direction and air pressure massage function can relax stiff calf muscle from longtime standing. 3 kneading options available.
- Roller massage function: roller massage and gua sha (scraping) for sole.
- · Footrest automatic detection function: after setting the height of the calf rest, it will automatically detect the length of the feet and reach the targeted massage areas.
- SL-shaped ultra-long rail perfectly matches the human body shape, ensuring a close-fitting massage from neck to thigh.
- Equipped with a 7" touch screen monitor.
- LED atmosphere lights are installed on the sides of the armrests.
- · O2 Ionizers are installed around the arm area.
- USB charging port on the right armrest.
- The upper arm has 2 width levels. Lightly push the armrest to adjust between the 2 levels.
- · Automatic reset function: the chair and the massage hands automatically resume to starting position when turned off.







### ( 2. Massage Function Operation

- 1. Begin massage (power button)
- In "standby" mode, there is no access to any massage modes.
- Press the power button to activate the massage program. The monitor will be set to the opening page while the back and calf rest will be set to the default position. Choose your desired massage programs (auto-massage programs or manual settings). The massage chair will automatically shut down if no order received after 5 minutes.





- Smart Al: Quick Refresh, Fresh Morning, Good-night Sleep, Joint Care, Frozen Shoulder, Spine Massage.
- Healthcare: Office Regimen, Sport Recovery, Mobile Zombie, Vacation Unwind, Waist Care, Humpback Fix.
- 3. Special: Pain Relief, Noon Recharge, Deep Massage, Bottom Toning, Circulation Boost, Tiredness Relief.
- 4. Relaxation: Full-body Stretch, Thai Massage, Chinese Massage, Total Relax, Airbag.
- The back and calf rest will automatically be set in position according to the selected auto-massage program.
- After the angle is set, the chair will automatically detect shoulder position and body shape (note: detecting only shoulder position for "Frozen Shoulder"; full body detection for other auto-massage programs). Press " w button to skip the detection process and directly begin the program.








- When detection is over, there will be "tik tik" sound. Further finetune the position of the massage hands using the " ▲ " and " ▼ " buttons, if needed. There are 11 finetune adjustment levels for shoulder position. If there is no adjustment after 10 seconds, the massage will begin automatically. Or, press the "confirm" button to directly enter the massage program. If the shoulder position is not detected, the massage hands will be set at the default height to begin massage.

#### 2. Pause Button

- When the massage is in progress, pressing the " • " button will stop all massage functions; and pressing " • " button again will resume them. If the pause time exceeds 20 minutes, all massage functions will automatically shut down.

- 3. Massage Intensity for Upper Body (3D Button)
- In Massage Information page, pressing the " or " to button will adjust the massage intensity of the mechanical hands for the upper body. There are 5 intensity levels in total.





Note: Massage intensity: 3D massage refers to the total forward or backward movement of all the mechanical hands. Massage intensity adjustment is applicable to a certain massage area. The massage intensity of each massage point has been checked during body shape detection. Adjust the intensity with this button if needed.

#### 4. Auto-massage Program

There are 4 characterized massage settings in the auto-massage program:

- Smart AI (Quick Refresh, Fresh Morning, Good-night Sleep, Joint Care, Frozen Shoulder, Spine Massage)
- Healthcare (Office Regimen, Sport Recovery, Mobile Zombie, Vacation Unwind, Waist Care, Humpback Fix)
- Special (Pain Relief, Noon Recharge, Deep Massage, Bottom Toning, Circulation Boost, Tiredness Relief)
- Relaxation (Full-body Stretch, Thai Massage, Chinese Massage, Total Relax, Airbag)
- · A total of 23 auto-massage functions
- Click the auto program button for auto-massage. When an auto-massage function is in progress, speed and width are not adjustable
- Click "More" to see the according auto-massage function

- Press the "X" button to exit the Manual Massage Function page.

- In the Manual Massage Function page, you can choose the massage mode, back stretch, the massage speed and the width between massage hands.
- Manual (Mode): kneading, tui na, tapping, kneading and tapping, shiatsu, 3D and grasping.
- For tapping and shiatsu, the width between the massage hands can be adjusted. Adjust the speed of the any massage modes while in motion. Press the "x" button to exit the Manual Massage Function page.

#### 6. Customization

- Press the " button to enter the Customized Massage Function page to access the memory programs named as Customization I, Customization II and Customization III.
- To save the massage functions or alter saved the massage functions.
- Save: to save the present massage settings, including the massage modes, air pressure, chair angle and all the other massage functions.
- Use: to alter the saved massage settings, including the massage modes, air pressure, chair angle and all the other massage functions.
- Press the " x " button to exit the Customized Massage Function page.

#### 7. Angle Adjustment

### 1. Recline angle adjustment

Button	Description	
Seat-Up	Press and hold this button to raise the leg rest. Release the button to stop the motion. When the height is set, the auto-detection function will begin to examine the foot length.	
Seat-Down	Press and hold this button to lower the leg rest. Release the button to stop the motion. When the height is set, the auto-detection function will begin to examine the foot length.	
Seat-Up	Press and hold this button, the back cover will slowly ascend while the leg rest will slowly descend. Release the button to stop the motion. If the massage chair is completely sit-up, it will stop the motion automatically.	
Seat-Down	Press and hold this button, the back cover will slowly descend while the leg rest will slowly ascend. Release the button to stop the motion. If the massage chair is completely laid down, it will stop the motion automatically.	

### 2. Zero-gravity

I ZERO	Zero-gravity I: Automatically set the position of the leg rest and back to Zero-gravity I.

### 3. Leg and foot length adjustment

#### 8. Setting

- Press " " button to enter the Setting page to access functions such as brightness adjustment, screen time adjustment, volume adjustment, serial no. and languages.
- Press the " x " button to exit the Setting page.



#### 9 Bluetooth

- Press the " " button to turn on/off Bluetooth function. " " means Bluetooth off; " means Bluetooth on.
- Once connected to the Bluetooth of the massage chair, you can use your smart device to play music through the 3D speakers installed in the chair.

#### 10. Time Adjustment

- Press the " to button to set the time of the massage. Each press adds 5 minutes to the current duration of the massage. The total duration cannot exceed 40 minutes. Time will return to its minimum value after exceeding 40 minutes.









### 3. Turn off power, cease massage

- Cut off all power.













#### 4. Armrest Installation


- 1. Locate the connection plug corresponding to the armrest from the bottom of the frame and then pass it through from the bottom center of the frame (Pic 1).
- 2. Connect all the plugs accordingly and properly (with reference to the markings on the actual objects) (Pic 2).






- 3. Make sure all the connection wires regarding to the armrest from the bottom of the seat are connected, and the air pipe is also firmly attached (Pic 3).
- 4. After all the related wires are connected, gently tuck them under the seat along the steel pipe in the middle of the frame. Mind the rupture of the air pipe (Pic 4).










- 5. Hold the tip and the rear end of one armrest with both hands. Insert first the shaft at the rear end of the armrest into the hole on the metal frame of the seat. Uplift the armrest slight to check if the shaft is locked firmly (Pic 5).
- 6. When the rear end of the armrest is firmly attached, hook the tip of the armrest to the metal frame of the seat and then press it for fastening. Shake the armrest a little to check if the it is installed properly (Pic 6).







- 7. Through the mounting holes on the tip of the armrest, screw the two M5x14-12.9 zinc-plated internal hex screws and the 6x12x1.5 zinc-plated flat washer with the provided 4# Allen wrench to affix the armrest to the metal frame of the chair (Pic 7).
- 8. Screw the rest of the armrest to the chair with five M4x10 screws (Pic 8).





- 9. Insert the hooks at the bottom of the armrest decoration in the groove under the armrest. Use the two metal locks in the middle to affix to the armrest (Pic 9).
- 10. From the inner shoulder area of the armrest, use one ST4.2x12 screw to attach firmly the armrest decoration to the armrest. Shake slightly the armrest again to check its stability. Repeat the same steps for the other armrest (Pic 10).









### 5. Leg Rest Installation


- 1. Cut the cable tie on the connection wires and the air pipe (Pic 1).
- 2. Connect the connection wires and the air pipe from the frame to those from the calf rest properly. And then tuck the wires and the air pipes inside the bottom of the chair. Mind the rupture of the air pipe (Pic 2).






- 3. Put the inner and outer rotating sleeves on the left and right shafts of the calf rest (note: the thicker side of the cover faces inward) (Pic 3).
- 4. Open the rotating shaft cover of the chair (Pic 4).






- 5. Hang the calf rest (by the left and right shafts) on the rotating shaft of the chair (Pic 5).
- 6. Close the leg rest cover, which should be pressing the tube covers (of the leg rest shaft). Use the provided 4# Allen wrench to screw the two M5x14-12.9 zinc-plated internal hex screws and the 6x12x1.5 zinc-plated flat washer to fasten the cover. The calf rest installation is complete (Pic 6).








7. Clamp the groove at the rear end of the footrest cover is on the pin axis, and then press the tip of the footrest cover until it is parallel to the rotating shaft cover plate, and the convex points at the sides of the footrest should be stuck in the holes at the sides of the footrest hook. The footrest installation is complete (Pic 7).




### 6. Touch Screen Monitor Holder Installation


- Take out the holder from the accessary bag. Attach the mounting flange of the holder to the armrest (Pic 1).
- 2. Use two M4 screws to affix the flange tightly on the armrest (Pic 2).





- 3. Place the two metal plates of the decorative cover on the square frame on the armrest, and then push them into the frame to lock them tightly (Pic 3).
- 4. When the installation is complete, shake slightly to check if it is stable (Pic 4).









### 7. Headrest & Back Cushion Installation and Use

Using the headrest can lessen the massage intensity borne by the neck and shoulders.
You may choose to use the headrest according to your own needs (recommended). Back
cushion is attached to the back through zipper (1); headrest is attached to the back
cushion through Velcro tape (2).



### 8. Floor Protection

The floor may be damaged due to the heavy pressure from the massage chair. It is advised to place a floor mat or other materials as a buffer to prevent the damage.



CAUTION: Do not move the chair with its wheels on a bumpy ground or in a narrow space. Two people are required to lift the chair. Hold the leg rest cover and the dent in the back cover while lifting the chair (please do not lift from the armrest).



### 9. Moving the Massage Chair

Before moving the massage chair, make sure no power cords and any cables are on the floor. Two people are required to move the chair, one in front and one at the back. Uplift the chair from the front while press downward at the back. When the focus completely lies on the wheels, push and move the massage chair to a desired destination and slowly erect the chair



CAUTION: Please make sure all the power is cut off before moving. The power cord and all other cables should be disconnected



### **Cleaning and Maintenance**

#### Cleaning

- Before cleaning, please make sure the switch has been turned off and the power plug has been disconnected from the socket.
- Use soft cloths to clean the surface of product and control panel.



- Do not pull the plug from the socket with wet hands.
- Please do not rinse the product. Avoid water/ liquids from getting into the product.
- Do not use corrosive cleaning agents like benzene or thinner to clean the product, otherwise, the color of product will fade, and the internal parts may be corrupted or broken.
- Do not disassemble the product when it is humid. Simply let it dry.

#### Maintenance

- Make sure that the plug has been disconnected from the socket before maintenance.
- Keep the product clean and away from high-temperature/ humid areas, or any environment with volatile gases.
- If this product is to be left idle for long, properly cover it with a dust cover (self-purchase).



Please keep the product away from direct sunlight, or high temperature, to avoid fading or product damage.



#### Kind Reminders

- \* If the product has been used for long, please check the conditions as below:
- Burnt smell.
- Unstable power supply after contact with the power cord.
- Power cord heating up.
- Power cords damage.
- Other abnormalities.



- If above mentioned happens, please stop using the product.
- Switch off the power supply, pull out the plug, and contact us.
- Do not disassemblee the product by yourself.



### Maintenance and Cleaning of PU Leather

PU leather is made by the coating and drying of polyurethane. Compared with genuine leather, PU leather is more resistant to tear, heat and sunlight. Depending on its nature and chemical substances, however, it should be kept away from any dusty, high/low-temperature, humid environment, under direct sunlight or places with corrosive substance. Otherwise, the leather could tear, quickening aging and hydrolysis.



### Cleaning:

- Please do not use organic reagent or grease solution, especially strong solvent, e.g. alcohol, turpentine and thinner, to clean the surface of the PU leather. Otherwise it will corrode the surface.
- Please do not use water or washing powder to clean the surface of the PU leather. Otherwise there will be cracks.
- 3. When cleaning the surface of the PU leather, choose a cleaning agent that has a pH value of between 5~7, no dentifrice, and is harmless to the environment.
- For dirty PU surface, apply egg whites to the surface using a piece of soft cloth. Avoid using a brush for cleaning.

#### Maintenance:

- Keep a good ventilation indoor, overly dry or humid environment can accelerate the aging of leather
- 2. Please keep the product away from direct sunlight or air vent, otherwise the leather will be hardened. Direct sunlight will also cause fading.
- 3. People are generally sweatier in summer. The holes on the surface of the leather will absorb sweat. While heat and high humidity prompt the chemical reaction between certain substances in sweat and the leather, and hence, causes smell. Please clean the surface more often with a piece of lightly wet cloth.
- 4. Please do not use alkaline cleaning agents on the leather. It will adversely affect the elasticity of the leather and lead to cracks as a result.
